## This funding will be used to


- Improve student literacy and numeracy performance across Stretton State College as per NAPLAN results in Years 3,5,7,9

## Our initiatives include


- Providing targeted intervention for students identified at all ability levels with personalised programs to maximise their achievement and growth in literacy and numeracy
