

2020 Night of Stars Awards Criteria

Academic Subject Excellence Award (Medallion & Certificate)

Criteria:

- Prep** Presented to the highest achieving student in English, Maths, Science and Physical Education
- Year 1–4** Presented to the highest achieving student in Maths, Science, English, Humanities and Social Sciences, and Physical Education
- Year 5–6** Presented to the highest achieving student in Maths, Science, English, Humanities and Social Sciences, Physical Education and Languages
- Year 7–12** Presented to the highest achieving student in each subject as reported on in Semester 1 2020.

Learning Excellence Awards (Medallion & Certificate)

Criteria:

- Prep** Presented to the students with three A's (A's in English, Maths and Science at end of Semester 1 2020)
- Year 1–6** Presented to the students with four A's (A's in English, Maths, Science and Humanities & Social Sciences at end of Semester 1 2020)
- Year 7–9** Presented to the students with a minimum of four A's and remainder B's (must have A's in English and Mathematics) as reported on in Semester 1 2020.
- Year 10–12** Presented to the students with a minimum of four A's and remainder B's (Must have an A in English or Mathematics) and at least three of the A's in General Subjects, as reported on in Semester 1 2020.

SPIRIT Excellence Awards (Medallion & Certificate)

Criteria: Presented to **students** who have consistently exhibited the values of the Stretton SPIRIT over all areas of school life, and who provide an outstanding role model to other students in their year level.

Prep–6 Presented to one student in each class.

Year 7–12 Students or teachers may nominate students in Years 7-12.

The Executive Principal and/or Campus Principals may nominate student leaders or any student/s deserving of a SPIRIT award based on the above criteria.

NB. Where there are anomalies to be considered, the Executive Principal and Campus Principals reserve the right to the final decision on ALL awards.
